Fireworks – What a fabulous evening we had last Friday! With your help the Fundraisers raised over £4000 which will be spent on our children. There are still some raffle prizes to collect. Please check the Fundraisers Facebook page or ask in the School Office.

Work Sharing – Year 4 parents are invited to go to the hall at 8.55am on 13th November to share their children's work with their youngsters. Children whose parents cannot attend will stay in class for assembly. Parents need to be at school by 9am at the latest so that the children can be collected from registration as a group, rather than disrupting the learning of those in class throughout the session. Children will need to be back in class ready to learn by 9.30.

Coats & Bags – Please remember that children play and learn outside in all weathers. They need to bring named coats to school even if they travel to school in a car. Now that children are bringing coats to school there is very little room in our cloakrooms and so we would ask that children bring smaller school bags with them if possible.

Scooter Parking – Can you please make sure that children's scooters are left tidily at our scooter park, any that are left at the end of the day will be put away.
