Mathletics – The school has decided to cease its subscription to Mathletics as school budgets are tight and we feel that other strategies are now available which are accessible by all pupils. However, because we currently subscribe parents can take out their own subscription for Mathletics at a significantly discounted rate of £6 for one year (normal home subscription costs £59 per year) as long as 31 more parents or more take up the offer. If you are interested please pay £6 on Sims Agora and you will be sent a login/activation to start using Mathletics at home. This is not available for Reception Children.
