Year 2 and 6 – Well done to our wonderful year 2 and year 6 children who have demonstrated amazing commitment and dedication to their work this week during their SATs. I would also like to say well done to all the staff who have worked with the children this week so that it was a stress-free experience.

No Excuse for Bad Parking! – We will be displaying a banner next month reminding everyone that there is no excuse for bad parking. Children will be taught why it is dangerous to park on pavements, near schools and on junctions. Please consider our neighbours and your children's safety when you park.

Holly Trees Talent Show – With so many children asking on the playground we are pleased to announce that this years' talent show will take place on the morning of Monday 25th June, so get practising!

Plastic Awareness – The school council have decided that we need to be more conscious as a school of the amount of plastic we use, particularly single use items. The Senior Leadership Team have discussed the issue and are looking at ways we can further reduce our eco footprint. For example, one suggestion from the children is to ensure that all water bottles are reusable. Of course if you are able to continue this at home the impact will be all the greater.

Fire Drill – We carried out our regular practice last week so that we are prepared to evacuate the building in the case of an emergency. I am sure you will be reassured to learn that the whole school was satisfactorily evacuated in less than one minute.

Meet The Teacher – This year we are inviting parents to meet their children's new teachers on 17th July in the main hall from 4pm-5.30pm. As parents have already been invited to share children's work on a number of occasions we will not be looking at books. However, any completed work will have been sent home for you to see how they have progressed.

New Play Equipment – Our new play equipment will be installed during the week beginning 18th June. We ask that you supervise your children after school even more than usual during that week.
